Listed below are the 2019 poverty guidelines published in the Federal Register on February 1, 2019 by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Figures refer to monthly income.

<u>Poverty Level</u>	<u>Single Person</u>	<u>Couple</u>
<i>100% poverty</i>	At or below \$1,041	At or below \$1,409
<i>125% poverty</i>	\$1,042 - \$1,301	\$1,410 - \$1,761
<i>150% poverty</i>	\$1,302 - \$1,561	\$1,762 - \$2,114
<i>175% poverty</i>	\$1,562 - \$1,821	\$2,115 - \$2,466
<i>200% poverty</i>	\$1,822 - \$2,082	\$2,467 - \$2,818
<i>Over 200% poverty</i>	\$2,083 or over	\$2,819 or over
