

Senior Cafés – Greater New Haven

LifeBridge Community Services provide Senior Cafés at sites throughout the Greater New Haven area for anyone 60 or older. These cafés offer nutritious and well-balanced meals. The menus are planned for optimal flavor, appearance and variety and are certified by a registered dietician as meeting one third of the daily recommended allowance for good health. Weekly menus are published in the New Haven Register. Anonymous donations are accepted at all locations. We suggest \$3.00 per meal but participants may donate whatever they can afford.

The sites are operated Monday through Friday and lunch is served between 11:15 and 12:30 at most sites. Participants must register for the program and are asked to make a reservation at the site the day before intended participation.
